Monica was a working Equity actor and singer in 2011 rehearsing the role of the Mother Abbess in *The Sound of Music* at Olney Theatre Center when a loss of balance landed her at the bottom of an open orchestra pit rather than on a stage platform. The accident resulted in a spinal cord injury causing her to be paralyzed from the mid-chest down with some loss of hand and arm function

Monica's extensive musical theatre background makes her well-suited for OCT's *The Who's Tommy*, based on the beloved rock opera of the 70's. Her credits include Iowa Housewife in *Menopause the Musical*, Mrs. Fezziwig/Mrs. Dilber in *A Christmas Carol* at Ford's Theatre, Smitty in *How to Succeed in Business...* at Heritage Repertory Theatre, and Maria in *Lend Me a Tenor* at West End Dinner Theatre.

"OCT has been a launch pad for talented actors who were born with disabilities or have become disabled later in life. To give a space for them to hone their craft playing roles often not provided to actors with disabilities in the professional theater world is vital. Empowering Monica to reclaim her identity as a performer is why OCT exists."
